GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Under the direction of the Program Supervisor, facilitates the development of individualized Wraparound Plans with families of children with Serious Emotional Disturbance (SED) through the Wraparound process. Assists families in identifying and accessing resources, clinical treatments, and other services to promote the child/youth functioning successfully in the home, school and community; performs services as part of a Child and Family Team and in coordination with a wide variety of agencies and community supports including DHS, Family Court, and the schools; Performs services primarily in the home and community; performs related work as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Master's in Social Work and Michigan Master's Level Social Worker (LMSW) credential, Clinical **AND** one (1) year of experience working with children, adolescents and their families in a clinical setting. Will consider a candidate with a Limited License as a Master's Level Social Worker (LLMSW) credential, Clinical **AND** one (1) year of experience working with children, adolescents and their families in a clinical setting. The employee with an LLMSW must take and pass the ASWB Examination within six (6) months of hire to retain employment. The employee with an LLMSW must also make application for the LMSW upon completion of 4000 hours in order to retain employment.

OR

Master's in Psychology and Michigan Limited Licensed Psychologist (LLP) credential. **AND** one year experience working with children, adolescents and their families in a clinical setting. Will consider a candidate with a Temporary Limited License Psychologist (TLLP) credential **AND** one (1) year of experience working with children, adolescents and their families in a clinical setting. The employee with a TLLP must make application for the LLP upon completion of 2000 hours in order to retain employment. Effective 6/30/2010, all new Master's level psychologists must take and pass the Examination for Professional Practice within six (6) months of hire to retain employment.

OR

Master's in Counseling and Michigan License Professional Counselor (LPC) credential **AND** one (1) year of experience working with children, adolescents and their families in a clinical setting.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must submit a copy of college transcriptions with application. Must retain DCH qualifications as a Child Mental Health Professional. Must complete DCH Wraparound Training. Must have a valid Michigan driver's license, current automobile insurance, and the use of a vehicle during work hours. Ability to physically perform the tasks.

Veterans must submit Form DD214 to determine eligibility for Veterans' Preference
